HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES

This is a simple way of creating half square triangles with no waste!


Cut a square 3/8" of an inch larger than the finished size of the piece including seam allowances. (For a half square triangle piece to have a finished size of 2" then you need to cut the square 2" + 1/2" + 3/8" = 27/8")

Cut two squares, one in each fabric that you are creating the half square triangles in.

Draw a diagonal line across the back of one of these as in the picture and stitch a scant 1/4" either side of this line.



Cut apart on the drawn line.



Press the seam towards the darker fabric.

Trim Dog Ears.

Check with a ruler to see that the square is the finished size required.

If its **small** then that means your $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams are too big.

It its **too big** then it means that your $\frac{1}{2}$ seams are too small.
